

SJYCSF 420 Sailboat Usage Policy (To Be Posted)

Primary Purpose of the 420 Sailboats – The 420 sailboats are owned by the SJYCSF to serve the students of the SJYCSF. The cost of maintaining the 420s is primarily covered by student sailing program fees.

General Statement Regarding Use of the 420 Sailboats – The SJYCSF 420 sailboats will be used for the purposes of educating SJYCSF students in sailing and sailboat racing techniques; for SJYCSF students practicing their sailing and sailboat racing techniques; by instructors who are practicing their sailing and sailboat racing techniques; and by the SJYCSF when it is hosting youth regattas. All SJYCSF student use must be properly supervised by SJYCSF instructors or an SYC race committee.

Uses of the 420 Sailboats that are Explicitly Approved by the SJYCSF Board:

- Student use during SJYCSF classes.
- Youth regattas hosted by the SJYCSF.
- Senior instructors, but not junior instructors, may use the 420 sailboats outside of class time to practice their sailing techniques if prior approval is obtained from the Sailing Program Director.
- Students sailing together may use a 420 sailboat during SYC weekend races if prior approval is obtained from the Sailing Program Director.
- Students sailing with an adult may use the 420 sailboats during SYC weekend races if prior approval is obtained from the Sailing Program Director.

Tuesday night 420 sailboat races - These races are run by the SJYCSF with the objective of giving SJYCSF students and instructors an opportunity to improve and practice their sailboat racing techniques. Preference will be given to current students, instructors, and parents. Those who are explicitly invited to participate are:

- Current SJYCSF students, instructors, and parents.
- Past SJYCSF students, instructors, and parents.
- Other adults who are sailing with a current SJYCSF student in the same boat.

Exceptions to these usage guidelines can be granted by the Sailing Program Director.
